



Project Update



Works begin to create new pedestrian friendly zone

From **Monday 22 May, 2017** work will commence on the creation of a new pedestrian zone linking the hospital main entry, the car park currently under construction and the new Emergency Department driveway.

The works primarily involve realigning pavement levels and minor footpath works as well as installing paving and will be progressed in three stages over a three month period.

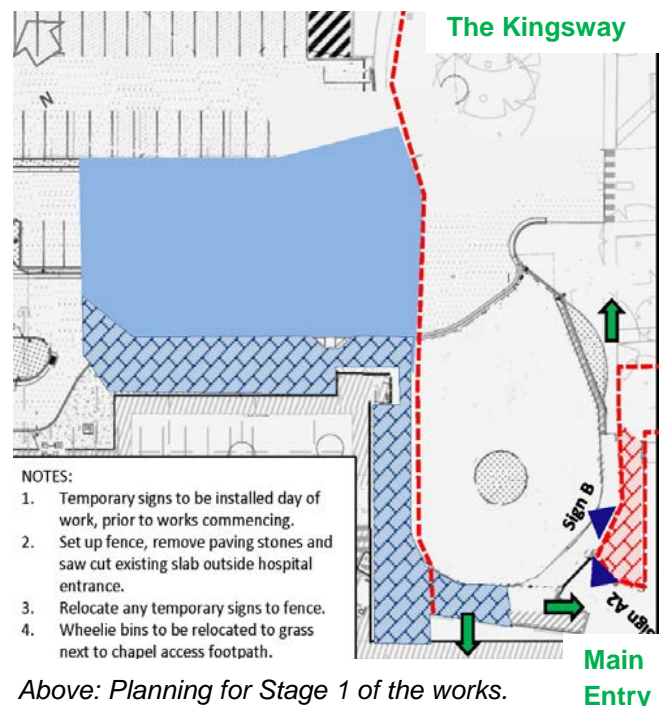
For Stages 1 and 2, site fencing will be set up to exclude the work zones (as indicated in red for Stage 1) along with new wayfinding signage to assist pedestrians and drivers.

It will be necessary for small concrete trucks and rubbish removal vehicles to be on site during various stages of the works. Traffic management personnel will be on duty to ensure staff, patient and visitor safety during these times.

Accessibility for staff, patients and visitors will be maintained at all times. This includes a dedicated drop-off and pick-up zone near the hospital main entry and provision for disability parking.

The location of site fencing will change as the works progress to Stage 3. We will provide more information closer to these works.
